THE "BLUE FLAG" **PROGRAMME**

The **«Blue Flag»** is a programme of environmental awareness, protection of nature and sustainable management which is implemented every year in 50 countries around the world by the national members of the Foundation for Environmental **Education (FEE).**

It aims at improving management and visitor safety at the marinas, while at the same time protecting their natural environment, so that we may always enjoy them.

The **Hellenic Society for the Protection of Nature (HSPN)** is the national operator of the programme in Greece. It is the first environmental NGO in the country and has been active in environmental education and nature conservation since 1951.

It is not easy for a marina to be awarded the Blue Flag. It must meet **38 strict criteria**, which have to do with the cleanliness of the marina, its organisation, visitor safety, the protection of nature and environmental awareness. Even when a marina is awarded the «Blue Flag», it can only raise it for one year and must prove that it deserves it for the following year. The inspectors of HSPN and FEE visit marinas throughout the year and note any problems or shortcomings. Usually a short period of grace is allowed to correct them, but a marina may temporarily, or even permanently, lose its flag for



CRITERIA

Environmental awareness

- Information about nearby sensitive and/or
- A Code of Environmental Conduct is posted

- Environmental education activities.

Safety and Services

- Adequate and well signposted lifesaving, first-aid and firefighting equipment.
- Emergency plan in case of pollution, fire or other accidents.
- Electricity and water available at the berths.
- Facilities for people with disabilities.

Environmental management

- Implementation of an environmental policy and plan at the marina. The plan should consumption, health and safety issues, and the use of environmentally friendly products.
- Adequate, separate and properly identified containers for the storage of hazardous wastes (paints, solvents, boat scrapings, antifouling agents, batteries, waste oil, flares)
- Sufficient waste bins.
- Bilge water pumping facilities.

- All buildings and equipment properly maintained in compliance with national
